

Inevitably as part of the manufacturing process, small visual imperfections may arise that our glass manufacturers are unable to eliminate. In some rare cases under certain environmental conditions, Low-E glass may produce condensation on the external face. This is impossible to predict but usually disappears with a change in temperature or humidity levels.



## **Exclusions**

Unless stated elsewhere, we have not included for; any electrical wiring, provision of scaffold or hire of cranes, removal of existing frames &/or glazed units, any preparation works required as per our drawings issued or disposal of any existing frames &/or glazed units from site unless otherwise stated & agreed with an additional cost confirmed & added to the contract.

### **General Conditions**

Unless stated elsewhere, our quotation is based upon the following assumptions;

- We are installing to square & true openings prepared by the client's builder/contractor.
- All works are to be carried out in a single uninterrupted visit during normal working hours on a ground floor location. Manual haulage will be charged extra if required.
- The prices quoted include for all works detailed in this quotation & are valid only for the stated quantities.
- Prices are based upon delivery to the address given in this quotation.
- Prices assume that our vehicles can be parked on site or nearby free of charge.
- The prices quoted are valid for a period of 30-days from the date of quotation.
- Prices are subject to confirmed site survey dimensions after which, any variations to contract will be advised.
- Prices are subject to variation in the event of currency rate fluctuations.
- Urban & Grey Ltd will not be held responsible for any costs incurred in the event of late delivery due to circumstances beyond their control.
- Errors & omissions excluded.

## <u>Survey</u>

Urban & Grey Ltd will carry out a full site survey. This has been included in the price.



#### **Drawings**

The above price allows for Urban & Grey Ltd to provide a detailed drawing for approval. Unless otherwise directed, we will prepare our drawing based on our standard technical details and in accordance with our accepted quotation. In the event that changes are required to our drawing, we will levy a charge of £100.00 per drawing revision.

### Delivery

We estimate that delivery will be completed within **4 to 6 weeks** from placing the manufacture order with our fabricator. Please note that this is an anticipated lead time based upon current projected manufacture & installation times & is subject to seasonal change & demand. No allowance has been made for the time you take to approve our drawings or any necessary alterations. All such time delays must be added to the estimated time provided above. We will use our reasonable endeavours to complete the delivery & installation within the above time estimate but any dates for delivery or installation are estimates only & time shall not be of the essence of this Contract.

#### Installation

Should we find at the time of scheduled installation that the preparation works required completed in advance of our installation have not been carried out as per our instruction/drawings, we will postpone the installation to a later date suitable to our fitting schedule & issue an aborted visit charge equivalent to the daily installation rate of £695.00 plus VAT accordingly.

## Terms of Payment

30% of the total contract price is payable upon return of the signed Acceptance of Quotation form.

A further 40% of the total contract price is payable with drawing approval prior to manufacture.

A further 30% of the total contract price is payable 7-days prior to delivery.

If payment is not made on the dates specified, then we reserve the right to withhold delivery or to terminate the contract without further notice.

#### Personal Data

By requesting this quotation or agreeing to this order, you are also consenting to your personal data being stored for as long as is necessary for the purposes set out in our Privacy Policy. Personal data includes title, name, address, phone number & email address. This data will be used to provide essential documentation & will be retained on files for the lifetime of the guarantees, which do not exceed 10-years.



#### **Warranty**

Our aluminium profiles are subject to a ten-year manufacturer's warranty period on the frame finishes. In the event that the product becomes faulty within the first 12-month period from the date of installation practical completion, Urban & Grey Ltd will undertake to repair the fault free of charge. Thereafter, a service charge for the labour required will become applicable.

Our glazed units, including bespoke roof lights, are subject to a five-year manufacturer's warranty period against failure of the hermetic seal resulting in the formation of condensation within the cavity. Please refer to our Terms & Conditions below regards this & the warranty period on working components, electrical components, in-glazed blinds & lock cylinders.

The following are excluded from the warranty; breakages to glass/glazed units including roof lights once installed, damage caused by misuse or incorrect installation of components (unless installation is carried out by Urban & Grey Ltd).

Upon certified completion of the installation, where a retention payment is applicable, the final payment is payable. We require written notification of any outstanding issues within 7-days of the completion date. The warranty will become only when full & final payment is made. Service calls will be chargeable unless a valid warranty is in place.

## **Terms and Conditions**

- Save where otherwise agreed in writing Urban & Grey Ltd ('the Company') shall execute the works on the following terms and conditions, which are incorporated into the contract between the Company and the customer and the acceptance of the Company's quotation will signify acceptance of these terms and conditions.
- 2. The Company shall comply with and give all notices required by any statute, any statutory instrument, rule or order or any regulation or bye-law applicable to the works and shall pay all fees and charges in respect of the works legally recoverable from it.
- 3. The Company shall complete the works in accordance with this quotation with due diligence and in a good and workmanlike manner using materials and workmanship of the quality and standards therein specified.
- 4. The Company shall use its best endeavours to complete the works within any period of time specifically agreed in writing between the Company and the customer, but this will not form the basis of the contract and the Company shall not be liable for any delays caused by reasons beyond its reasonable control, including but without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing, inclement weather and delays in obtaining materials from suppliers.
- 5. In the event of any variation to the works by the customer, either orally or in writing, this variation will be confirmed by the Company in writing and unless the order is rescinded within seven days shall be treated as confirmed.
- 6. Wherever possible a quotation will be given for any additional works or variations to the contract, but otherwise will be charged at a fair price based on the variation.
- 7. The Company will not be liable to the customer for any unforeseen site conditions not apparent at time of survey and without opening up the existing structure or groundworks.
- 8. If on installation the building is found to have any structural defects, infestation or other serious defect the Company shall inform the customer accordingly and agree to postpone the works until the customer, at the customer's expense, has rectified the problem.
- 9. In the event of any such postponement the Company shall be entitled to be paid for all materials on site.
- 10. All materials and equipment on site which form part of the contract works shall remain the property and be in exclusive possession of the Company until such time as the contract sum has been paid in full.
- 11. Value Added Tax will be charged at the rate prevailing at the time of completion of the works.
- 12. The Company shall be entitled to payment as follows and as detailed in this quotation:
  - a. Deposit with signed Acceptance of Quotation
  - b. Stage payments, as detailed on the Acceptance of Quotation
  - c. Balance in full prior to delivery or installation, as detailed on the Acceptance of Quotation
  - d. Retention balance due upon completion of installation where applicable on Acceptance of Quotation
- 13. The Company shall be entitled to charge interest on all outstanding monies at the rate of 5% over Bank of England Base rate prevailing at the time the monies are due.
- 14. In the event of any dispute arising during the course of or subsequent to completion of the contract, the customer will not be entitled to withhold payment in excess of an amount representing a reasonable valuation of the work required to rectify or replace any allegedly defective works which are the subject of the dispute.
- 15. The quotation includes for essential making good after fitting/installation but does not include for redecoration and ancillary works such as refitting curtain rails, alarms, telephone points etc.
- 16. In addition to its statutory obligations the Company guarantees the works against faulty materials and workmanship after installation as follows:
  - a. Aluminium frames and profiles are guaranteed not to have any structural deterioration for a period of ten years
  - b. Sealed double glazed units including rooflights are guaranteed not to form condensation within the cavity for a period of five years
  - c. All cylinder locks and electrical components are guaranteed for a period of one year
- 17. This guarantee is Insurance Backed by Fair Trades/Homepro Insurance.
- 18. This guarantee is conditional on the works being adequately and properly maintained and does not cover any physical damage caused by misuse, impact, abrasion, or cleaning with a non-proprietary chemical.
- 19. Notice of any claim under this guarantee must be made in writing to the Company within fourteen days of the alleged defect becoming apparent.
- 20. This guarantee is not transferable unless requested in writing and agreed to by the Company, and is subject to an administration fee, which will be advised by the Company at the time of the request.
